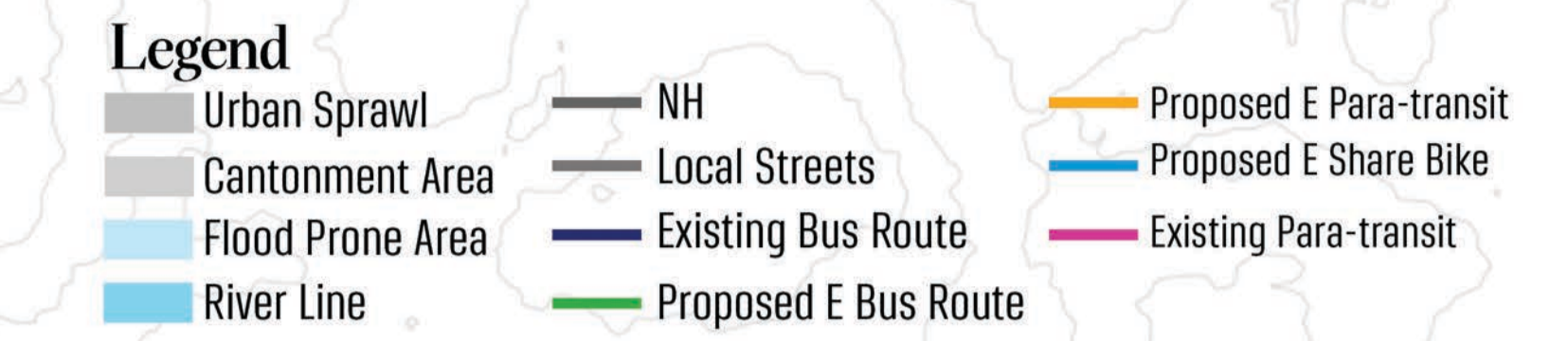
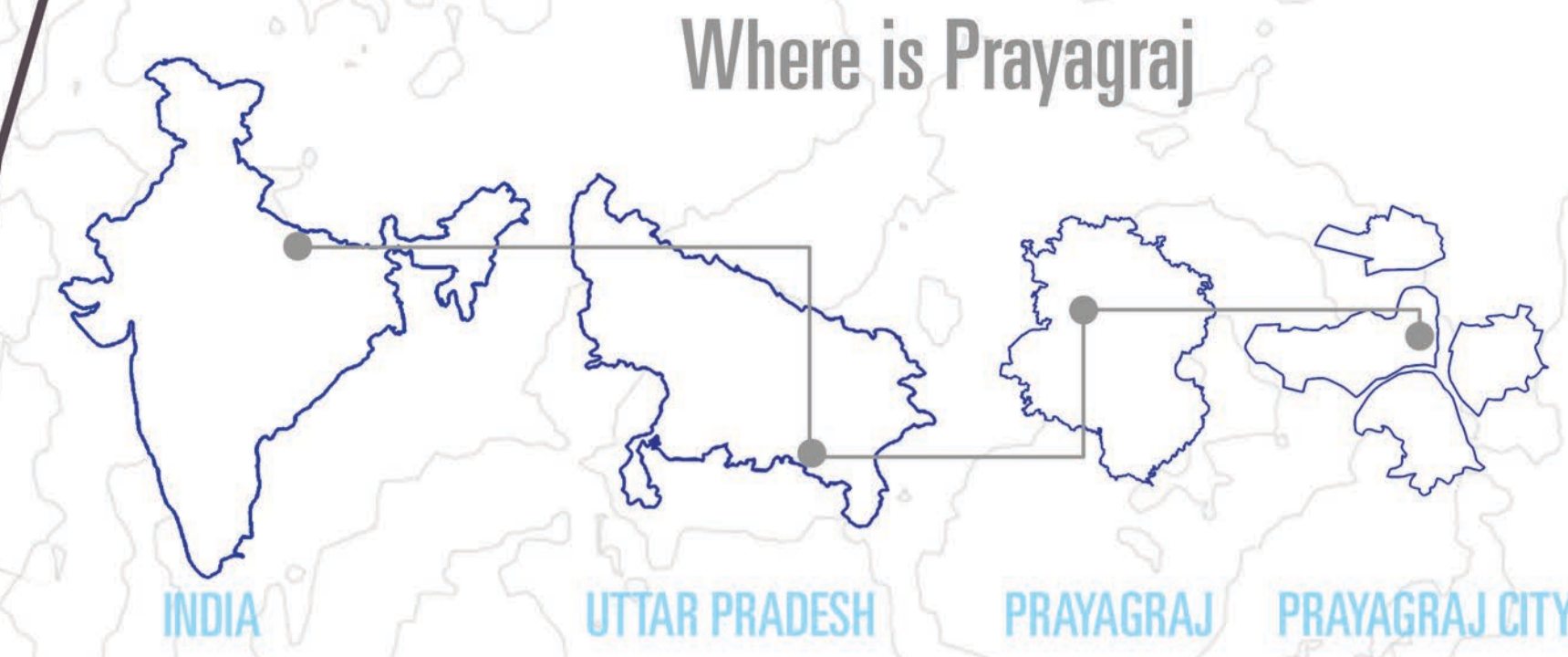


About the City

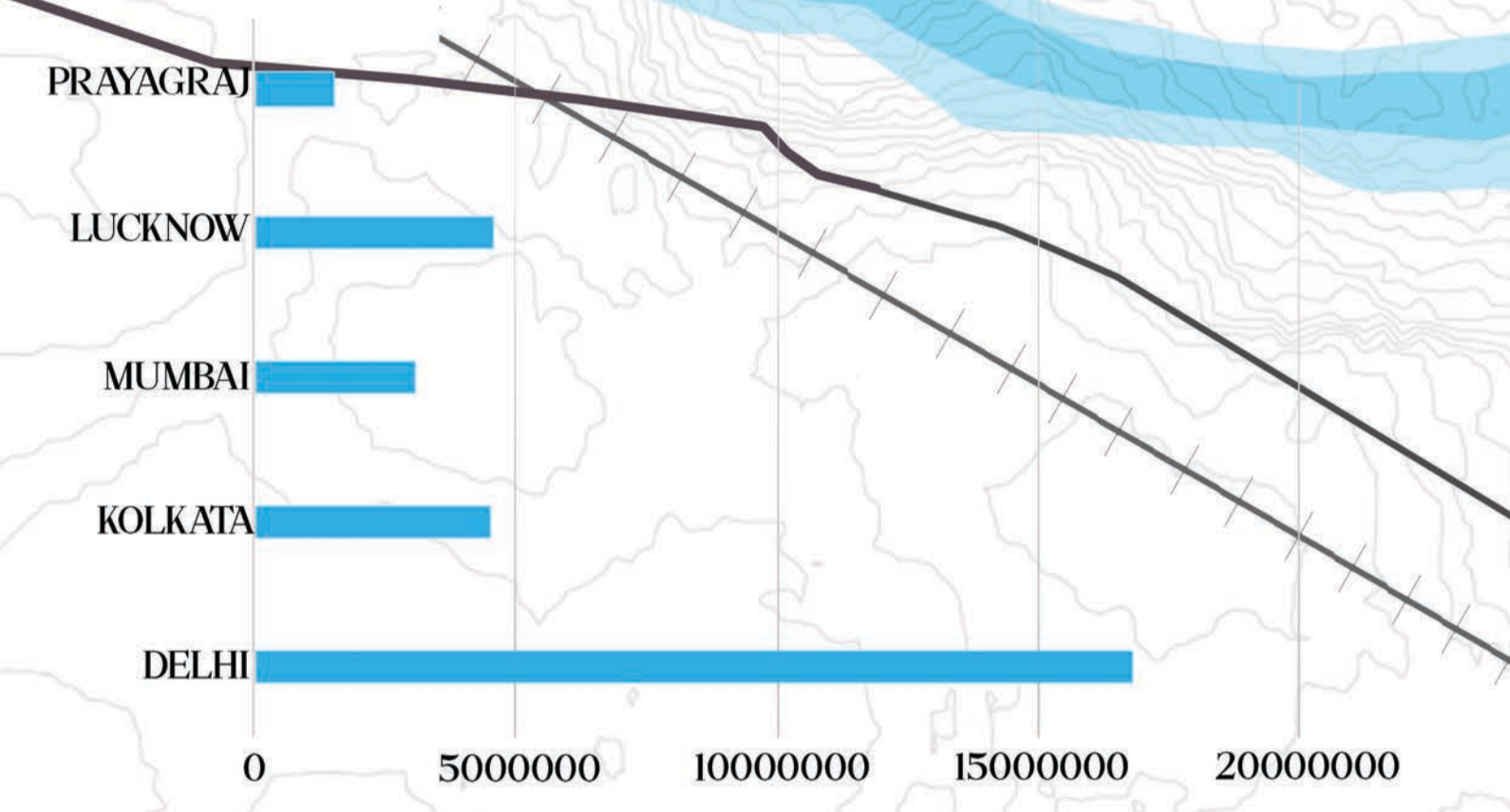
